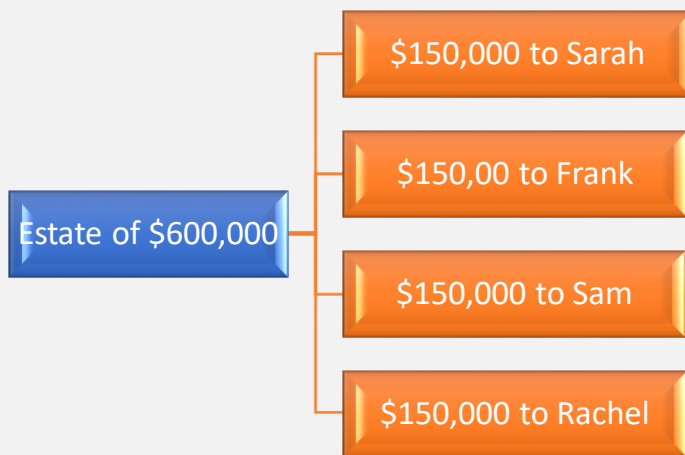
George and Ann have 4 children. Their after-tax estate is valued at \$600,000. Their children are all comfortably well-off.

Example 1:

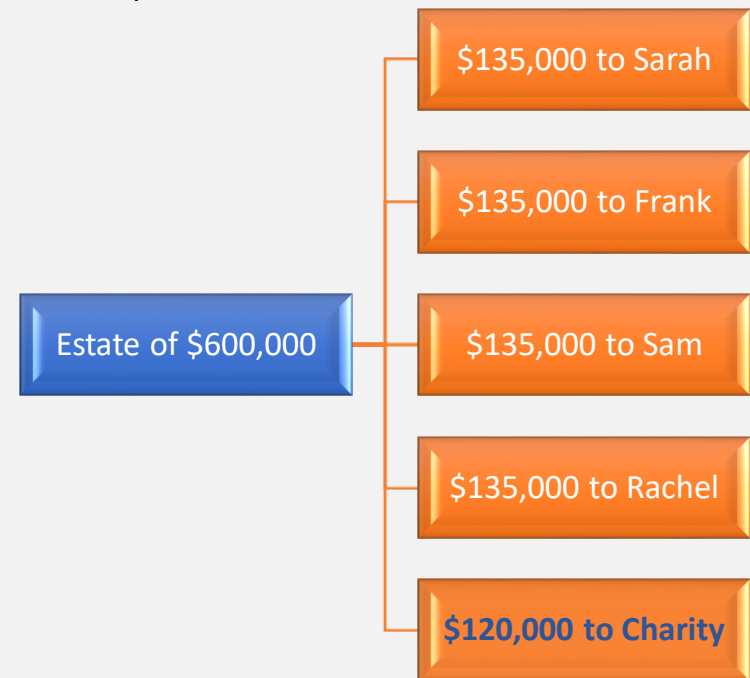
The estate is simply divided evenly between the children. The estate is split evenly between 4 children, plus an additional

Example 2:

'child' named Charity. The charitable donation generates a tax credit of \$60,000 which is then split between the 4 children.



TOTAL GIVING: \$600,000



TOTAL GIVING: \$660,000!

A proportionally small reduction in the amount given to your children could lead to a substantial gift to the ministries and charities that have meant a great deal to you. Careful planning of your estate giving can maximize the impact and legacy you leave behind!
